Remote Learning Information

Dear Parents and Carers

Class Calls From tomorrow, there will be two class calls a day for every class in the school. The calls have been timetabled so that they do not clash with another class. This will allow siblings from different classes who are sharing a device to attend their respective calls.

Morning Register – 15 minutes per class

- 8.45am – Class 1
- 9.00am – Class 2
- 9.15am – Class 3
- 9.30am – Class 4
- 9.45am – Class 5

This is a chance for teachers to introduce the work for the day and for children to ask any questions arising from work that they have been doing.

Afternoon Live Sessions – 30 minutes per class

- 1.00pm – Class 1
- 1.30pm – Class 2
- 2.00pm – Class 3
- 2.30pm – Class 4
- 3.00pm – Class 5

In the afternoons, children will have the opportunity to share the work they have been doing with their teacher and their peers.

Class calls will appear on the 'Calendar' area of your child's teams account and can be accessed on a PC, laptop, tablet or mobile phone using the Teams app or website. **We expect all children to attend all of their class calls.** If you have access issues, e.g. internet connection, number of devices available etc., then please call me at school.

Learning Resources

With the short notice of the current lockdown, we were unable to provide all children with new exercise books to work in as we did in March. If your child still has their previous home learning book, they can continue to use that. There are resources (exercise books, pencils etc.) available for collection from underneath the bike shed. These resources will be outside all day, every day so that you can collect what you need at a convenient time and in a socially distanced way.
