



Covid-19 FAQs

What if my child has Covid-19 symptoms (a new continuous cough/fever/loss of taste or smell?)	Your child must not come into school <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You are strongly advised to arrange for your child to be tested (www.gov.uk/testing-for-coronavirus) You should inform school immediately with the result of your child's test 	Your child can return to school when the test produces a negative result
What if my child tests positive for Covid-19?	Your child must not come into school <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your child must self-isolate for at least 10 days Other members of your household should self-isolate for 14 days 	Your child can return to school after ten days even if they have a cough or loss of smell or taste as symptoms can last for several weeks after the infection has gone
What if somebody in my household has Covid-19 symptoms?	Your child must not come into school <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Inform school immediately The person with symptoms must get a test Each household member should self-isolate for 14 days Inform school of test result 	Your child can return to school if the household member's test is negative
What if somebody in my household tests positive for Covid-19?	Your child must not come into school <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Inform school immediately Each household member should self-isolate for 14 days 	Your child can return to school on completion of 14 days' isolation
What if NHS test and trace has identified my child as a 'close contact' of someone with Covid-19 symptoms/confirmed diagnosis?	Your child must not come into school <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Inform school immediately Your child must self-isolate for 14 days 	Your child can return to school on completion of 14 days' isolation
What if NHS test and trace has identified someone in my household as a 'close contact' of someone with Covid-19 symptoms/confirmed diagnosis?	Your child <u>may</u> come into school <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The household member should self-isolate for 14 days Other household members do not need to self-isolate unless original contact develops symptoms (then all household members self-isolate for 14 days) 	Your child can return to school on completion of 14 days' isolation
What if my family/child has returned from a destination where quarantine is required and has to self-isolate?	Your child must not come into school <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Inform school immediately Family+child must self-isolate for 14 days 	Your child can return to school on completion of 14 days' quarantine
