
Dear Parents and carers

Court Hill: Thursday 7 July to Friday 8 July 2022

We are now in the process of making the final arrangements for our trip to The Court Hill Centre, Court Hill, Nr Letcombe Regis, Wantage, OX12 9NE.

Transport

We need parents to help us with this as it keeps the costs down. Could you please drop your child off at the Court Hill Centre by 9.30am on Thursday 7 July; teachers will be there to welcome the children for the start of the day. At the end of the trip, please arrange to pick your child up from the Centre at 3pm on Friday 8 July.



Travel Directions to The Court Hill Centre

Take the A417 to Wantage. As you enter the Market Place, take the first left into Newbury Street. Follow this road (A338) until you are nearing the top of The Ridgeway. Turn right into Court Hill Road (signposted to Letcombe Regis) and the Centre is immediately on your left.

Cost

We need to ask you to pay for the cost of the overnight accommodation and this is available to pay on [SCOPAY](#). We are happy to accept instalments. The contribution of £36 covers accommodation and food.

Food

The children will need to bring a substantial packed lunch, including a bottle of water (that can be refilled), with them for the first day. We would also really appreciate any homemade cakes or cookies that you are willing to provide as the children get such an appetite in the fresh air, we like to give them lots of breaks with snacks. Please remember though nuts are not allowed in any packed lunches or homemade cake/cookie donations.

All other food is provided by Court Hill (the children get a lovely cooked evening meal, a cooked breakfast in the morning and a packed lunch for their final day). It is also a requirement of the Centre that there is no food in bedrooms, so please do not be tempted to send your child along with any sweets.

Clothing

Your child will need a waterproof coat, t-shirt, fleece, warm trousers, (definitely not jeans as these chafe when wet and take forever to dry), sun hat, sturdy shoes, or trainers. In a small bag your child should have a full change of clothing, a small hand-towel, toothpaste and toothbrush, pyjamas, comb/brush, sun cream and a teddy is a must! No aerosols or hair gel etc.

Medication

Any medicine (labelled and in a small plastic bag) and handed to Mrs Rees on the first morning – a medication form will need to be completed for these.

If your child uses an inhaler they need to be responsible for this themselves and no medication form is required.

The school will take care of the First Aid kits.
